About Dissertation Editors

Editing the dissertation prior to publication is an important aspect of scholarly writing. Editors typically perform the following functions as part of the editing process:

- **Grammar and Proofreading** includes the proofreading and checking of grammar and mechanics. Spelling, punctuation, sentence structure, verb tense, word choice, pronoun referents, passive voice, clarity, and parallel construction are checked for accuracy and marked for correction if errors are found. Vague terminology is noted. Run-on sentences and fragments are marked for correction. Suggestions are made for structural coherence, transitions, and document flow.
- Style and Format Editing of the document, including Table of Contents and preliminary pages, is reviewed. Consistency, in-text citations, parenthetical documentation, margins, headings, spacing, numbered or bulleted lists, figures and tables, appendices, and reference list formatting are marked for correction. Formatting using APA sixth edition guidelines must be utilized.
- Citation to Reference verification is made and noted when citations are not in the reference section and references are not in the body of the paper as citations.
- University Specific Formatting is important. In situations where there are conflicting rules, the Argosy Dissertation Guide overrides the APA Manual. It is important for the student provide the editor with a current copy of the Argosy Dissertation Guide, as well as any additional documentation necessary for the editor to review the student's work.

Editors do not change the integrity or meaning of the content, write content, or delete portions of the content. Editors do not add missing information in reference sections but do note when additional information is needed.



Choosing an Editor

When choosing and editor:

- Discuss your specific needs and requirements (e.g. editor's availability to discuss any issues).
- Ensure that the editor can meet your due date.
- Review the cost and get the agreement in writing. Editors are paid up front.
- Ensure the editor stands behind his or her work.
- Know exactly what you'll receive for your money.
- Ensure that your editor has the most recent version of the Argosy Dissertation Guide.
