

Access the ProQuest **Digital Dissertations & Theses** database on the Find Articles & More page or the Find Dissertations page.



Use the **Browse** option to browse dissertations by subject or location.

#### Advanced Search

In the Advanced Search screen, you can search for specific fields.

This is useful when you want to search by options like Author(AU), ISBN, Subject Heading (SU), Reference (REF), or only in the citation and abstract -choose All fields (no full text).

**Subject Names** (also called Subject Headings) are terms from a predetermined list created by ProQuest editors. Dissertation authors then select from this list terms that they feel describe their dissertation.

**Index Terms**(also called author keywords and **DISKW**) are terms chosen by the dissertation author to describe their dissertation. These keywords are optional and not all authors may use them. Keywords are often natural language and may be useful for describing new research and ideas.








On a results page or dissertation page, you can find the following options.
